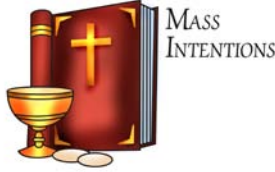

# Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 19, 2009

### First Reading: Jeremiah 23:1-6

In this passage, God denounces false leaders who have scattered his people. He promises that they will be reunited and led by one who is just and wise.

### Second Reading: Ephesians 2:13-18

Paul explains that through Jesus Christ, there is no longer hostility between Gentile and Jew. Instead, through the Spirit of Christ, both groups become one body and are equal in the eyes of God.

### Gospel: Mark 6:30-34

The apostles returned after their first mission and told Jesus what they had done and taught. He told them to rest, but the people kept coming to them. So they went to find a private place, but the people learned where they were going and arrived first. Jesus felt sorry for them and decided to teach them instead of resting.

## Year of the Priest Indulgences

All the faithful may gain a *Plenary Indulgence* under the usual conditions “who, in church or in chapel, devoutly attend the divine Sacrifice of the Mass and offer prayers to Jesus Christ the Eternal High Priest, for the priests of the Church, and any other good work which they have done on that day, so that He may sanctify them and form them in accordance with His Heart.” This Plenary Indulgence may be gained: “on the days in which the Year for Priests begins and ends [i.e., June 19, 2009 and June 19, 2010], on the day of the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the pious passing of Saint John Mary Vianney [August 4, 2009], on the first Thursday of the month or on any other day established by the local Ordinaries for the benefit of the faithful.” This Plenary Indulgence is likewise granted to the elderly, the sick and all legitimately confined to their homes, “provided that on the above-mentioned days they recite prayers for the sanctification of priests and confidently offer the illnesses and hardships of their lives to God through Mary, Queen of Apostles.” A *Partial Indulgence* is granted “to all the faithful every time they devoutly recite five *Our Fathers*, *Hail Marys* and *Glorias*, or another expressly approved prayer, in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to obtain that priests be preserved in purity and holiness of life.”

The conditions for receiving a *Plenary Indulgence*, which is the full remission of time one would spend in purgatory, are:

1. Receiving Holy Communion and going to confession within a week.
2. Prayers for the Holy Father.
3. No attachment to sin, even venial sin.

The faithful may gain a *Plenary Indulgence* once a day for either themselves or a deceased person.
