### First Reading: Deuteronomy 4: 32-34, 39-40

### Second Reading: Romans 8: 14-17

Paul explains that through the Holy Spirit, we become children of God. As heirs of God we must be willing to suffer as Christ if we are to share in His glory.

### Gospel: Matthew 28: 16-20

Jesus asks His disciples to go to other nations and teach others all that they have learned. He asks that these new followers be baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
