Fasting and Abstinence

On Ash Wednesday and ALL the Fridays of Lent, everyone over 14 years of age is bound to observe the law of abstinence (no meat). On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, all those, 18 & up, to the beginning of their 60th year, are also bound to observe the law of fasting. On these two days, only one full, meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
